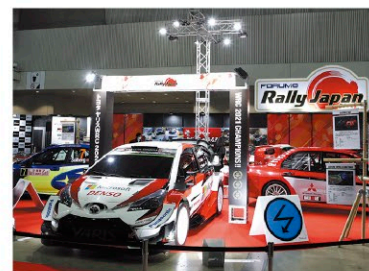
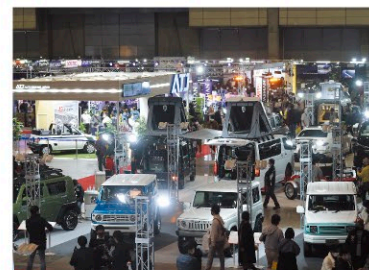

POST-EVENT SUMMARY REPORT on attendees

“Annual custom car extravaganza” held for the first time in two years

Taking the next step on the occasion of the 40th edition

Looking back a year ago, TOKYO AUTO SALON 2021 on-site at Makuhari Messe was cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The situation of the COVID-19 disaster with no clear future has remained unchanged since then, and the 2022 show was again subject to severe restrictions. And yet we joined hands with the exhibitors and we have managed to hold an “annual custom car extravaganza” for the first time in two years.

TOKYO AUTO SALON's biggest charm should be that the show gives you the opportunity to spot the latest trends in the automotive industry as well as to experience the forefront of the custom industry first-hand. With signs of the Omicron variant spreading, fans must have been hesitant to travel across borders. However, as it turned out, visitors came from all over the country to feel the atmosphere of the custom car front line with all their senses. We understand the inconvenience caused by the various infection prevention measures visitors had to follow. Yet, the look on the fans' faces brightened, as if to wipe away the days of anxiety. For us the organizer, it was great to see the car enthusiasts enjoying the show for the first time in a while.

Inaugurated in 1983 as “Tokyo Exciting Car Show”, TOKYO AUTO SALON marked its 40th anniversary. The show has been growing over the years and, in recent years, it has also become firmly established as a significant opportunity by many automakers to unveil their new car as well as announce their motorsport activities for the year.



TOKYO AUTO SALON 2022 was held with a 50% attendance limit per day, and the hall was designed to ensure a wide flow line between booths. Each booth was equipped with hand sanitizers, face shields for staff members and sneeze guards for stage content. The 2022 show was devised to enable both exhibitors and visitors to fully enjoy.

TOKYO AUTO SALON has grown into a big event that caters not only for die-hard car enthusiasts but for casual fans of all ages, with a variety of fun content including showcase and sales in each booth, demo runs at the outdoor arena and live show at the event hall featuring gorgeous lineup of performers.

With the arrival of the “New Normal” era, TOKYO AUTO SALON has also entered a period of further evolution. As a first step, the official website was completely revamped on the occasion of the 40th anniversary. The redesigned website introduced a new system called ONLINE AUTO SALON that goes beyond event information. It is a platform to effectively

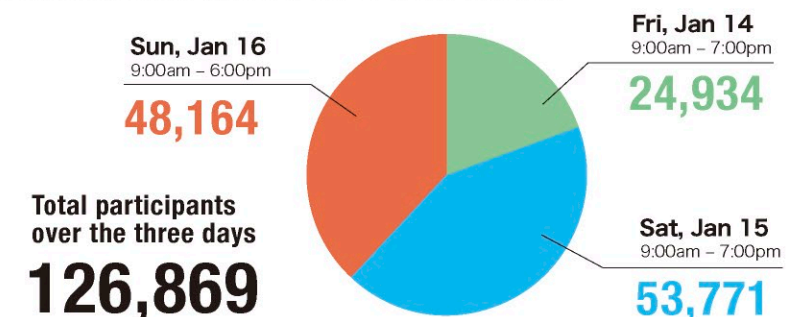
connect exhibitors and car fans, and will find potential for further business growth.

In recent years, the automotive industry has accelerated its move towards achieving carbon neutrality. Automakers all over the world are heavily involved in environmental initiatives, and the trend is spreading to the motorsport industry. This tendency, where greenhouse gas reduction is becoming the primary concern, is an irreversible, but even in these times, there is no doubt that many people still want to enjoy their cars and customise in a more genuine way.

Visitors' preferences are very wide ranging. Some want to drive an edgy sport car, some to spend a fun time with their family in a minivan, and others to have a well-designed SUV. There is also a diverse range of curiosity about customisation, such as making their cars faster, more fun and more fashionable. Having accepted the changing times TOKYO AUTO SALON takes a new step forward with unchanging charm

Friday 9am to 2pm usually is reserved for media and industry professionals as "silent time" where the exhibitors take full advantage of the opportunity to have a presentation and make new business contacts; and open specially to the public after 2pm. However, in the 2022 show, the first day was set aside for an all-day BtoB environment as "Business Day". There were fewer press conferences than usual, where new car launches and motorsport activities for the year was announced, with online conferences taking place instead. This was a different format from previous years, but perhaps it could also be sort of an evolution in line with the times.

Although the overall number of exhibitors and vehicles on display was fewer than in previous years due to the COVID-19 pandemic, wider lines of flow between booths were designed to avoid three Cs. In addition, each booth took its own measures against infection, e.g. the number of visitors entering the booth was controlled. Another feature of the 2022 show was that few exhibitors put up walls around their booths. The venue generally was comfortable and unobstructed to soothe visitors anxiety. We would like to thank all the exhibitors for their cooperation with the various infection preventive measures.

On Friday, the Event Hall hosted another press conference for "ALIVE HOON", a film about D1. D1 is now a world-class motorsport recognised by the FIA (Fédération Internationale de l'Automobile) which is also one of the most high-profile TAS categories. The film sure will provide an opportunity for more people to become aware of the appeal of drifting and fun with cars, and it was meaningful that the conference took place in TOKYO AUTO SALON.

The show opened to the public on Saturday and the first content of the day was the JEGT Grand Final in the Event Hall. JEGT is an e-sports competition using Gran Turismo SPORT, which gaming fans around the world get hooked on, and the final round of the 2021 series of team competitions was held at TOKYO AUTO SALON 2022. As e-sports are spreading across the world, this Grand Final attracted a lot of attention. The battles, which are every bit as good as those of real motorsport, were heated and the event was a great start to the first day open to the public.

Also in the Event Hall, the annual "Japan Race Queen (grid girls) Awards Ceremony" was held on Saturday, while "AUTO SALON SPECIAL LIVE", featuring a variety of spectacular performers, took place over two days on Saturday and Sunday. Although the number of visitors to the Event Hall was also limited, the venue was overflowing with enthusiasm.

In the outdoor arena, top drivers demonstrated their drift cars, and a radio DJ & car pundit Piston Nishizawa drove the new FAIRLADY Z, which just had its Japan premiere at Friday press conference. A large number of visitors gathered in the cold weather to catch a glimpse of the outdoor performances by various cool vehicles. The powerful outdoor content has been one of the signature and timeless content of TOKYO AUTO SALON that always stimulates the five senses and captures the hearts of car fans.

Despite the restrictions, visitors must have been able to enjoy the fun content of TOKYO AUTO SALON 2022.

Friday was the only media day in TOKYO AUTO SALON 2022, but even so, the show was covered in many media outlets including TV, newspapers, magazines and websites.



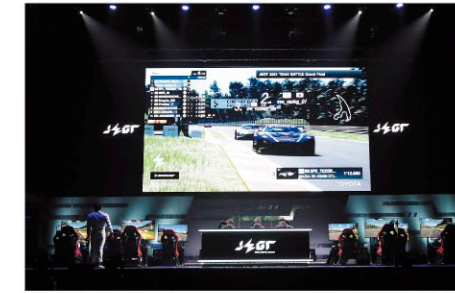

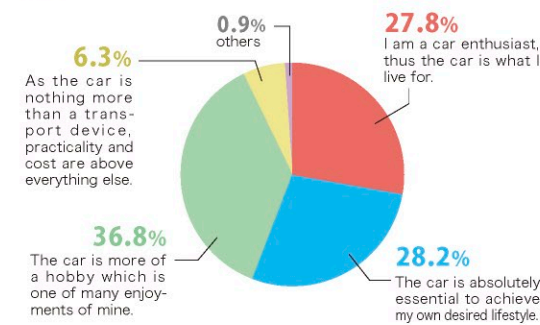
Age Group



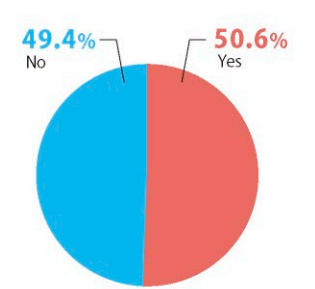
Trend in Age Group



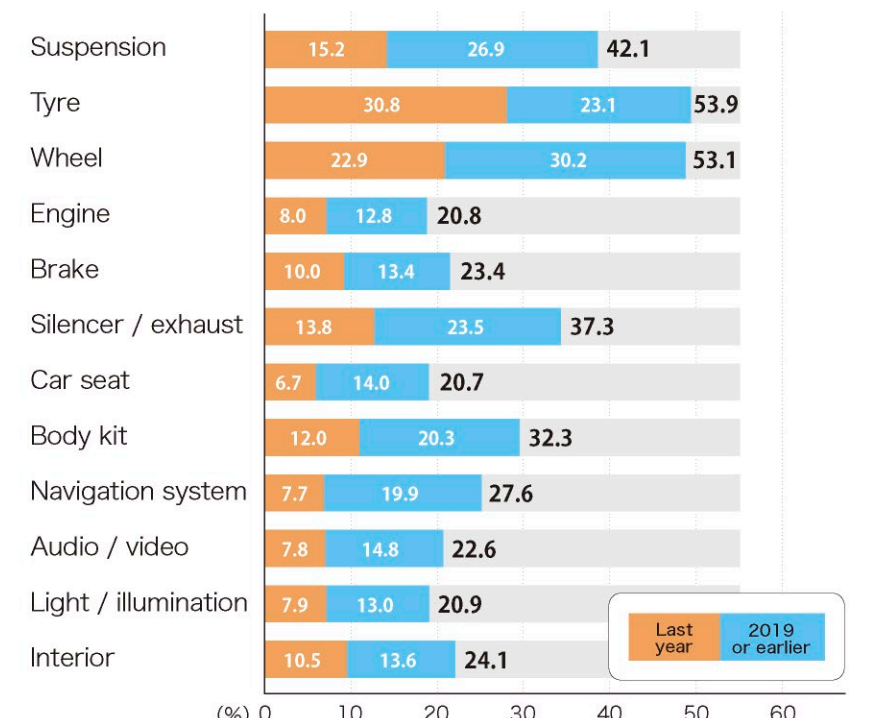
Q Which is most similar to your attitude about car?

TOKYO INTERNATIONAL CUSTOM CAR CONTEST 2022

Three winners each were voted in eight categories, of which the top winner was chosen as the category's best. TAS then engaged fans in voting the post-show online poll, and the top vote-getter won the Grand Prix.

Eligibility for Participation

Any vehicle taken part in TAS 2022 except purpose-built racing cars/past contest winners are eligible for an entry into the contest.

How the Winners Get Chosen

Winners in each category are determined by the visitor vote (as part of the questionnaire survey conducted on Saturday).

Contest Categories

The contest has below eight awards categorized according to how the car has been tuned/customized to the task it was intended to perform rather than the type of base vehicle by birth.

How the Grand Prix Get Chosen

TAS makes the eight top winners' photos accessible on our official website, and calls for the post-show online fan vote to choose one for the best - Custom Car Grand Prix of the year.



Award Winners in Each Category

Best Concept Car Award

Best Concept Car Award recognizes the most outstanding concept car of the year based on either 1) an original vehicle manufactured in an inventive approach or; 2) a production car-based vehicle heavily modified to achieve performance improvements as well as distinctive interior/exterior appearances, thus meant to be an advocator of a radically new concept. Cars entered in this category do not have to be street legal.

Best Award Winner

FAIRLADY Z CUSTOMIZED PROTO entered by Nissan Motor Co., Ltd.

Best Dressed-up Car Award

Best Dressed-up Car Award recognizes the most outstanding dressed-up car of the year designed to pursue stylistic fineness. The key criteria for consideration are dress-up excellence in appearance, technique and ingenious ideas for exterior/interior customization, and as to how well-finished overall. Cars entered in this category basically are display-dedicated and not have to be street legal.

Best Award Winner

VFS90R entered by Veilside CO., LTD.

Best Tuned Car Award

Best Tuned Car Award recognizes the most outstanding street-legal tuned car of the year that has been modified to produce even more power.

Best Award Winner

VARIS Kamikaze YARIS entered by VARIS

Best Sedan Award

Best Sedan Award recognizes the most outstanding street-legal sedan (saloon) of the year manufactured to achieve performance improvements as a desirable sedan. The key criteria for consideration are enhancement in the comfort of the cabin, unique ideas for dress-up and as to how well-finished overall.

Best Award Winner

NATS Low limo entered by NATS Nihon Automobile College

Best Minivan/Wagon Award

Best Minivan/Wagon Award recognizes the most outstanding street-legal minivan/wagon of the year manufactured to achieve performance improvements as a desirable minivan/wagon. The key criteria for consideration are enhancement in the accessibility of the utility space, unique ideas for dress-up and as to how well-finished overall.

Best Award Winner

ALPHARD entered by Suzuki Complete

Best SUV Award

Best SUV Award recognizes the most outstanding street-legal SUV of the year manufactured to achieve performance improvements as a desirable SUV. The key criteria for consideration are enhancement in the accessibility of the utility space, unique ideas for interior/exterior appearances and as to how well-finished overall.

Best Award Winner

DELTAFORCE JL WRANGLER entered by EXIZZLE-LINE

Best K-car/Compact Car Award

Best K-car/Compact Car Award recognizes the most outstanding street-legal K-car/compact car (light motor vehicle) of the year manufactured to achieve performance improvements as a desirable k-car/compact car. The key criteria for consideration are enhancement in the accessibility of the utility space, unique ideas for dress-up and as to how well-finished overall.

FAF Beach Van entered by Forest Auto Factory

Best Imported Car Award

Best Imported Car Award recognizes the most outstanding street-legal imported car of the year manufactured to achieve performance improvements as a desirable imported car. The key criteria for consideration are tuning excellence in engine and suspension, enhancement in the accessibility of the utility space, unique ideas for dress-up and as to how well-finished overall.

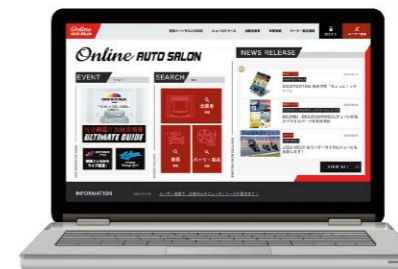
Online AUTO SALON

Live streaming in 3 languages delivered the excitement to the world in real time

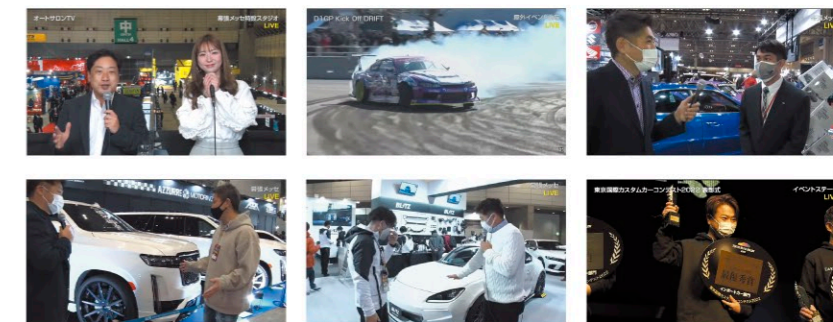
The official website has been revamped as ONLINE AUTO SALON, a web portal where exhibitors can get the word out effectively. Exhibitors have made use of it to showcase their vehicles & products on display as well as distribute press releases.

TOKYO AUTO SALON 2022 was live-streamed including the live coverage of the booths, Tokyo International Custom Car Contest to determine the best car of the 2022 show, the grand final of the e-sports competition (JEGT), and demo runs at the outdoor arena. On top of that, as a fresh attempt in 2022 to cater for those who could not make it to the venue both in and out of the country, we provided a multi-lingual streaming service in Japanese, English and Chinese. The total number of views over the three days reached approx. 420,000.

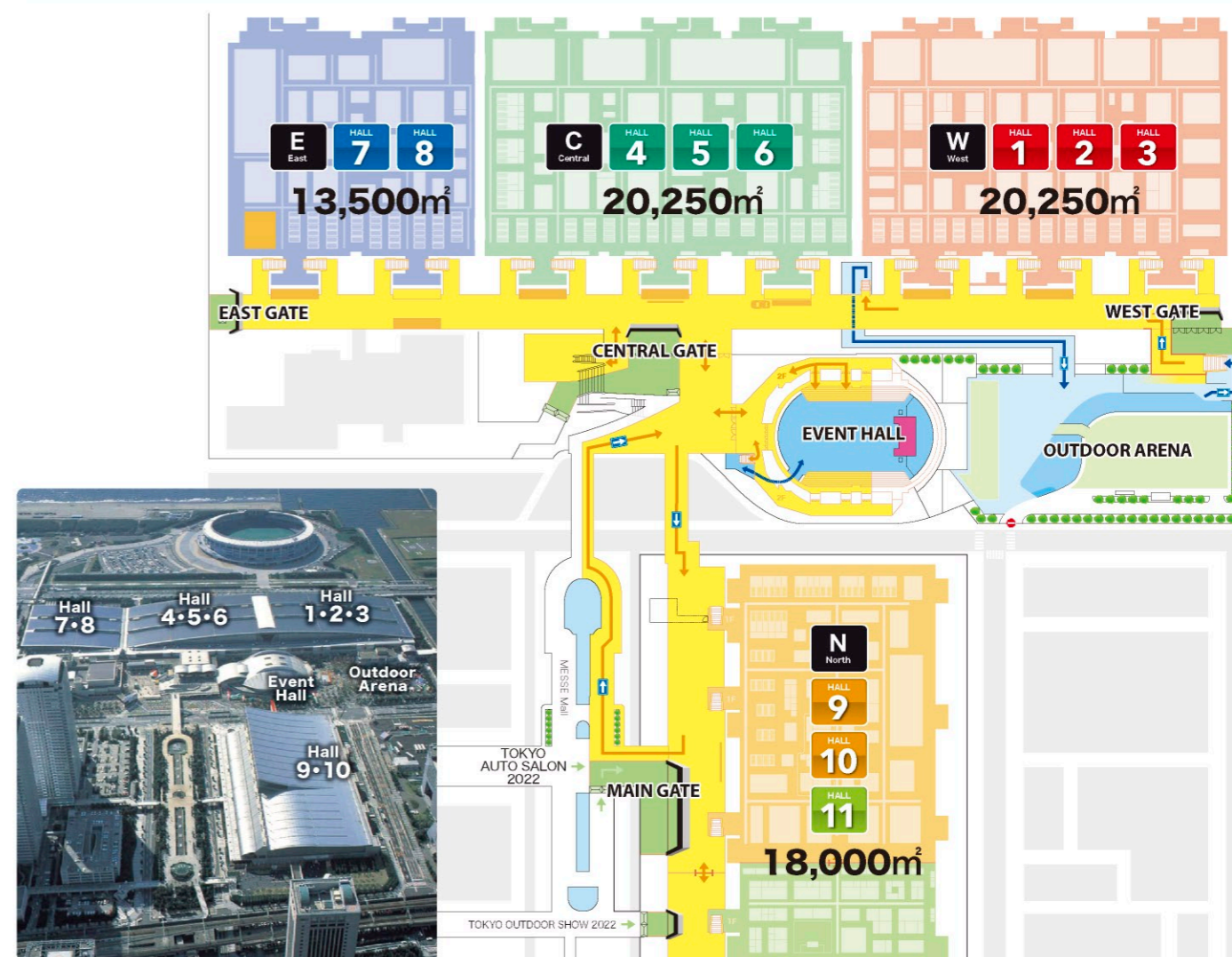
ONLINE AUTO SALON not only continue to offer video archives, but can also be a powerful platform for you to expand your business both during the show and throughout the year.

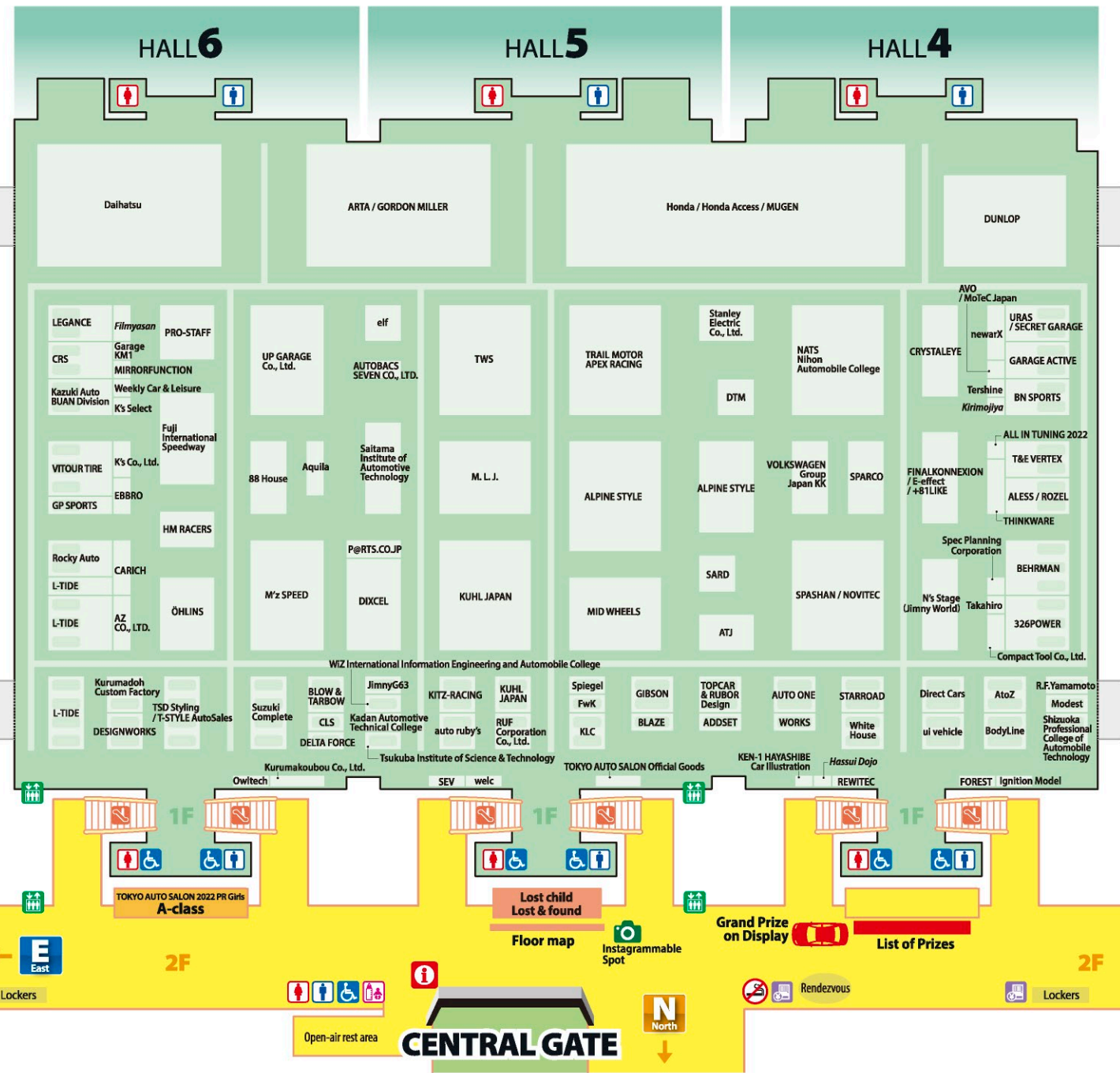


Live streaming views over the 3 days

Venue Overview





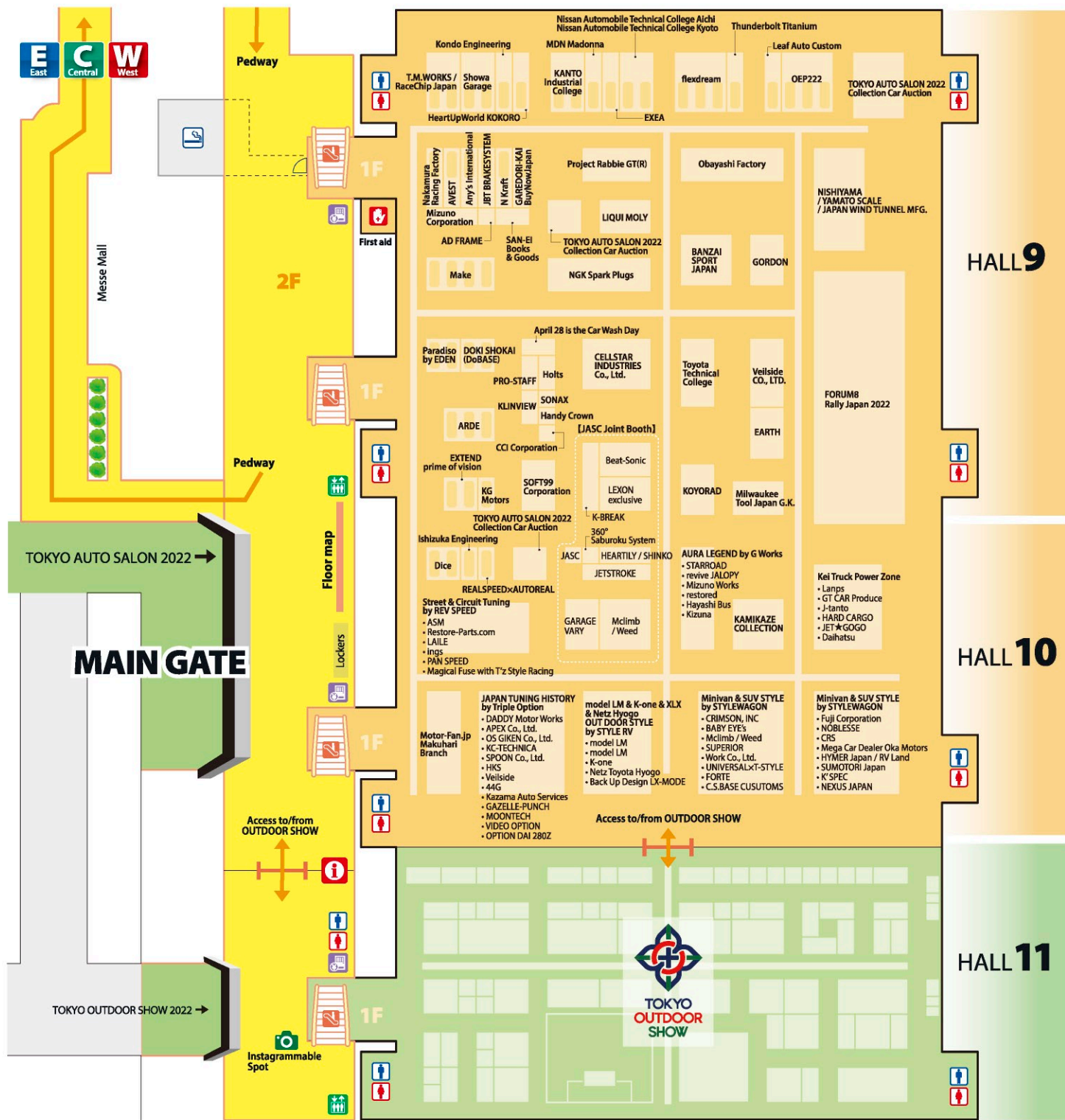
