From classics to futuristic — first full-scale TAS in 4 years has custom cars galore



The 42nd edition of TOKYO AUTO SALON turned out to be a great success. Since 2021, we have faced challenging times under various restrictions. Nevertheless, TOKYO AUTO SALON's growth never stops as an event cherished for a long time since the inaugural "Tokyo Exciting Car Show" in 1983, without interrupting the history. This has definitely been made possible with the passion, commitment and backing of the automotive industry, aftermarket industry, motorsport industry and numerous car enthusiasts. We will continue to create even better show to contribute to the those industries serving as a platform that connects the allure of cars to the new era ahead.

The 2024 show experienced a significant increase in the number of applications and was held occupying the entire Makuhari Messe for the first time since 2020. We had the participation of 378 exhibitors and 893 vehicles on display. A lot of car fans visited the show this time as well, of which it was remarkable to see a clear increase in visitors from overseas. While we had overseas visitors in last year, it was particularly noteworthy that this year saw

even more enthusiastic fans from various regions. Additionally, with the yen's depreciation, it is likely that there was an increased purchasing interest, contributing to a substantial inbound effect.

The 2024 show, compared to last year, also saw an apparent increase in family visitors. Given the risks of the COVID-19 pandemic, those with children were nervous about going out to places where many people gather, but such concerns have eased and made it easier for families to come. Although infectious diseases have not completely subsided, the venue was filled with a bright atmosphere with radiant smiles and lively voices of people from various backgrounds, all genuinely enjoying the "annual car extravaganza" just like in the past.

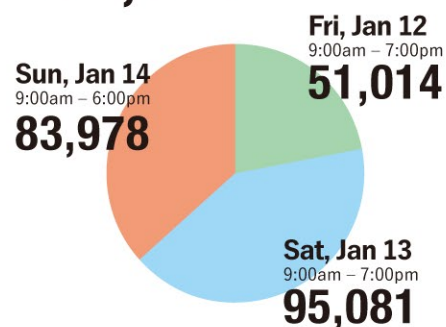
Looking around the vehicles on display, the TOKYO AUTO SALON's signature flavour, from classic tuning cars to glamorous dressed-up cars, were once again abundant this year. On the other hand, there were also many proposals for simple yet high-performance custom, aiming to enable users to continue enjoying their beloved vehicles for a long

time. On top of that, there was a noticeable lineup that conveyed the diversification of custom, including cars from automakers addressing decarbonization through EVs and renewable fuels, as well as tyres emphasizing sustainability. Such the initiatives instilled a sense of anticipation for further development in the automotive and custom industries. Even as we enter a new era, the challenges made by the exhibitors to meet users' needs will likely continue to captivate many car fans.

Introducing new content makes the show more attractive

TOKYO AUTO SALON has been consistently trying to improve visitor satisfaction by introducing new content to entertain car enthusiasts and casual fans alike. To achieve this, we have been working on various initiatives every year. A new addition to the 2024 content was the “e-SPORT EXPERIENCE”. An experience zone where visitors could try out e-sport was set up in the Convention Hall for three days starting Friday. Over the weekend, we hosted eight exciting programmes as stage events.

On Saturday, five ultimate competitions, using the top-tier racing car game series Gran Turismo, were waged wowing gaming fans worldwide. The venue buzzed with exclusive battles that can only be seen at TOKYO AUTO SALON, such as a special match where the TOKYO AUTO SALON promotional girls “A-class” teamed up with leading Gran Turismo competitors, and a dream match called “auto sport CUP” featuring top active racing drivers. The lineup on Sunday included “Street Fighter 6 Special Match” produced by a charismatic professional e-sport player “Dogura”, as well as the final round of Japan’s largest e-motorsport competition “AUTOBACS JEGT GRAND PRIX”. This new initiative generated significant excitement.

What took place in the Outdoor Arena was another TOKYO AUTO SALON’s signature programmes “Motorsports Demo Run”, featuring the ever-popular “D1 GP Kick Off Drift”, the “AE86 Showdown” and demo run sessions by the Nissan Formula E vehicles that competed in the 2021/22 season,

prior to the FIA Formula E World Championship scheduled for March this year in Japan. Despite the cold weather, a large number of spectators came to watch the adrenaline-pumping performances.

The Event Hall was also ablaze with excitement over live stages featuring luxurious performers, the Tokyo International Custom Car Contest 2024 award ceremony, the Japan Race Queen Award 2023 ceremony, and sing & dance acts by A-class. The exciting three days have come to an end in this way. We will continue to enhance the content and provide a diverse and enriching experience for visitors to discover their

own ways of enjoyment, and that they would want to visit repeatedly.

Lastly, we would like to express our heartfelt condolences to those who lost their lives and their bereaved families due to the 2024 Noto Peninsula Earthquake. Our deepest sympathies go out to all those affected by the disaster. During the course of TOKYO AUTO SALON 2024, we, the show organizer, collected donations for disaster relief. We express our sincere gratitude for the warm support and cooperation received from visitors and everyone involved. Our thoughts are with the affected areas, and we wholeheartedly pray for a swift recovery.

Our brand-new e-sport content offers another way to enjoy TOKYO AUTO SALON

E-sport has been garnering increasing attention in recent years, and the growth of the industry has led to a sharp rise in the number of professional players. It also has inclusive nature that allows participation regardless of age or gender. E-sport is expected to further expand its market size with even considerations for its inclusion in the Olympics. TOKYO AUTO SALON 2024 introduced a new content “e-SPORT EXPERIENCE” attempting to expand the car fan base and attracting the younger generation. It was made up of “Stage Content” for enjoyment through watching and “Trial Content” for interactive experiences using actual gaming consoles.

The Stage Content offered eight programmes over the weekend. Leading professional e-sport players and prominent guests made appearances, drawing a large audience to watch their heated matches live, which is often conducted online, in the onsite venue at TOKYO AUTO SALON.

“e-SPORT EXPERIENCE” featured two acclaimed titles, “Gran Turismo 7” and “Street Fighter 6”. With “Gran Turismo 7”, a unique dream match exclusive to TOKYO AUTO SALON, as well as the JEGT Championship, Japan’s top e-motorsport league, with a total prize pool of 5 million yen at stake took place. Additionally, hosting a special match in the widely recognized “Street Fighter 6” helped to attract a new segment of visitors. We have also heard that among them were individuals expressing an interest in custom cars and, from such the feedback, we believe that our new initiative contributed to the expansion of car fans and enhancing the overall event experience.

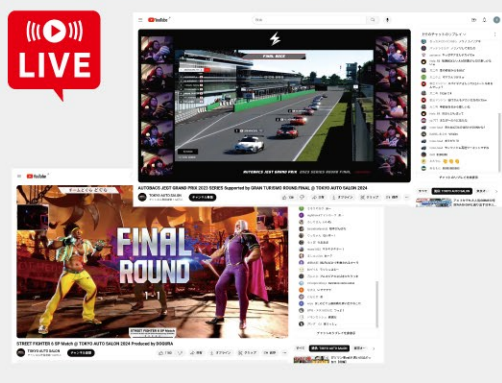

D1GP Kick Off Drift

Motorsports Demo Run is one of the iconic content of TOKYO AUTO SALON, of which the main feature is undoubtedly the annual “D1 Kick Off Drift”. D1 is a motorsport originating in Japan inaugurated in the year 2000 as “All Japan Professional Drift Championship”, shortly renamed as “D1 Grand Prix” in the following year. Unlike conventional motorsport competing genuinely in speed, D1 is a favoured series that focuses on the intensity and artistry of drifting. The year 2022 saw overseas expansion as “D1 OVERSEA”, with events held in various Asian countries including the Philippines, Thailand and Malaysia. The ever-popular D1 is a surefire content that always adds excitement to the Outdoor Arena at TOKYO AUTO SALON.

The 2024 show featured top-ranked drivers such as Hideyuki Fujino, who claimed the championship in the 2023 D1 Grand Prix series, along with Hokuto Matsuyama, Naoki Nakamura, Seimi Tanaka, Koudai Sobagiri, and most popular female driver, Sayaka Shimoda, took to the track. The MC was the regular commentator from D1 Grand Prix, Manabu Suzuki. Each session began with *tanso* (solo run) where the top D1 drivers showcased their splendid skills, and in the subsequent *tsuiso* (tandem run), they presented high-octane drift performances with side by side manoeuvres. The venue was enveloped in the distinctive scent of burning tyres, screeching sound of skidding and billowing white smoke, eliciting loud cheers from the spectators.

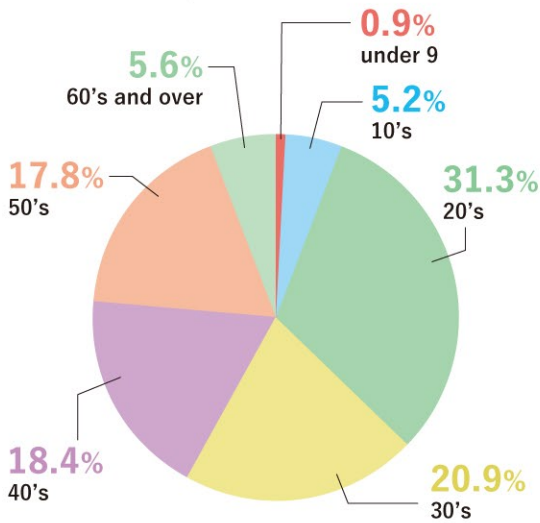

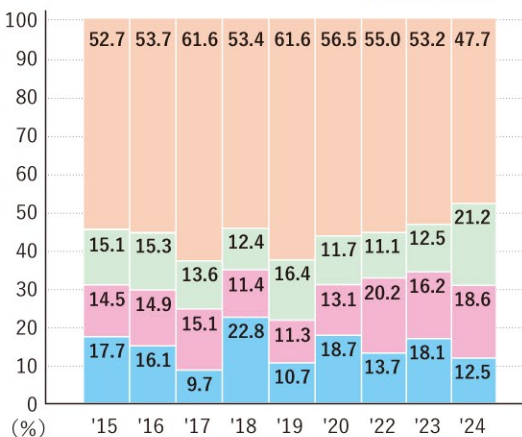

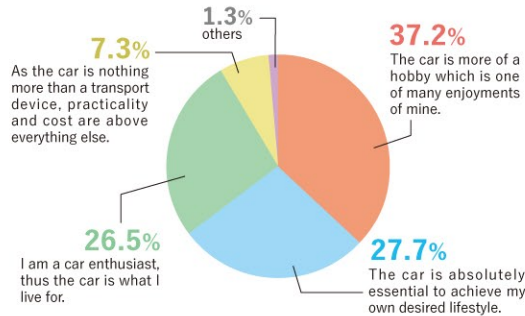
Age Group



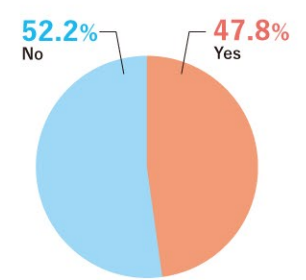
Trend in Age Group



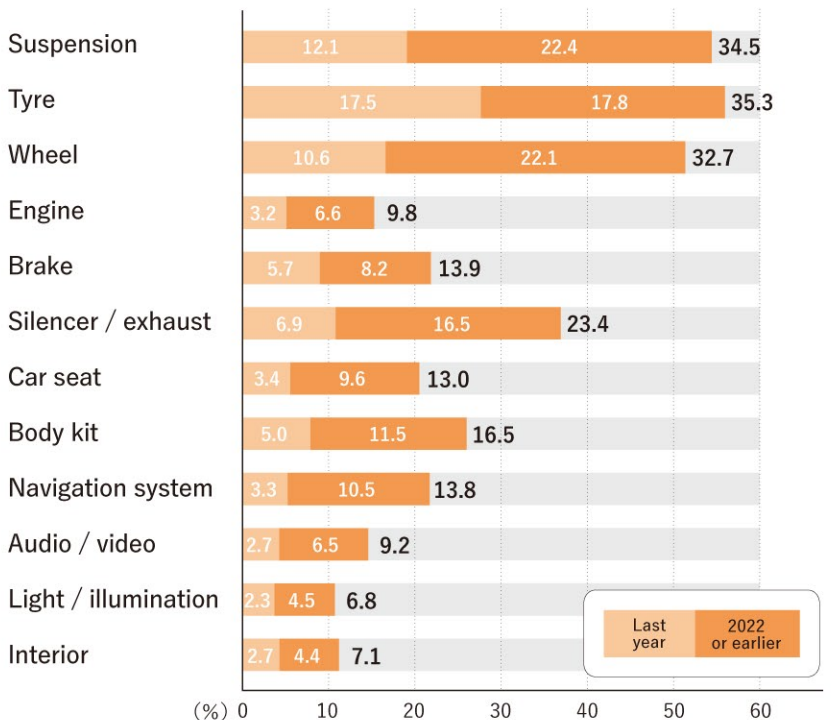
Q Which is most similar to your attitude about car?

Tokyo International Custom Car Contest 2024



The annual "Tokyo International Custom Car Contest" is an honourable competition where vehicles on display at TOKYO AUTO SALON can make an entry, and fans vote for their favourite one. The cars entered this year are all cool as usual. Let's have a look at this year's categories' best!

Eligibility for Participation

Any vehicle taken part in TAS 2024 except purpose-built racing cars/past contest winners are eligible for an entry into the contest.

How the Winners Get Chosen

Three winners in each category are determined by the visitor vote, conducted online between Friday 12 at 2pm and Saturday 13 at 7pm, of which the top winner is chosen as the category's best.

Contest Categories

The categorization has been revamped. The contest has eight awards categorized according to how the car has been tuned/customized to the task it was intended to perform rather than the type of base vehicle by birth.

How the Grand Prix Get Chosen

TAS makes the eight top winners' photos accessible on our website, and calls for the post-show online fan vote to choose one for the best - Custom Car Grand Prix of the year.

Winners in Each Category

Best Concept Car Award

LBX MORIZO RR CONCEPT entered by TOYOTA GAZOO Racing



Best Concept Car Award recognizes the most outstanding concept car of the year based on either an original vehicle manufactured in an inventive approach or a production car-based vehicle heavily modified to achieve performance improvements as well as distinctive interior/exterior appearances, thus meant to be an advocator of a radically new concept. Cars entered in this category do not have to be street legal.

Best Dressed-up Minivan/Wagon Awardee

ALPHARD entered by CRYSTALEYE



Best Dressed-up Minivan/Wagon Award recognizes the most outstanding dressed-up minivan/wagon of the year designed to achieve both performance improvements and stylistic fineness as a desirable minivan/wagon/commercial vehicle. The key criteria for consideration are enhancement in the accessibility of the utility space, ingenious ideas for dress-up and as to how well-finished overall.

Best Tuned Car Awardee

ACTIVE FULL DRYCARBON-R entered by GARAGE ACTIVE



Best Tuned Car Award recognizes the most outstanding street-legal tuned car of the year that has been modified mainly to produce even more power.

Best Dressed-up SUV Awardee

SUBARU LEGACY OUTBACK entered by TOYO TIRES



Best Dressed-up SUV Award recognizes the most outstanding SUV of the year designed to achieve both performance improvements and stylistic fineness as a desirable SUV. The key criteria for consideration are enhancement in the accessibility of the utility space, ingenious ideas for interior/exterior appearances and as to how well-finished overall.

Best Dressed-up Sport Car Awardee

GR 86 Carbon Spec / Drift entered by Kazama Auto Services



Best Dressed-up Sport Car Award recognizes the most outstanding dressed-up sport car of the year designed to achieve both performance improvements and stylistic fineness as a desirable sport car/coupe. The key criteria for consideration are excellence in exterior/interior design, technique and ingenious ideas for dress-up, and as to how well-finished overall.

Best Dressed-up Compact Car Awardee

Beas+ entered by ALPINE STYLE



Best Dressed-up Compact Car Award recognizes the most outstanding compact car (light motor vehicle) of the year designed to achieve both performance improvements and stylistic fineness as a desirable k-car/compact car. The key criteria for consideration are improvement of driving performance and utility, ingenious ideas for dress-up and as to how well-finished overall.

Best Dressed-up Sedan Awardee

PRIUS 60R-GTW WIDE BODY entered by KUHLE JAPAN



Best Dressed-up Sedan Award recognizes the most outstanding dressed-up sedan (saloon) of the year designed to achieve both high performance and stylistic fineness, of which performance improvement as a desirable sedan is the primary focus. The key criteria for consideration are dress-up excellence in appearance, enhancement in the comfort of the cabin, ingenious ideas for dress-up and as to how well-finished overall.

Best Imported Car Awardee

C8 CORVETTE FORTE WIDEBODY entered by FORTE



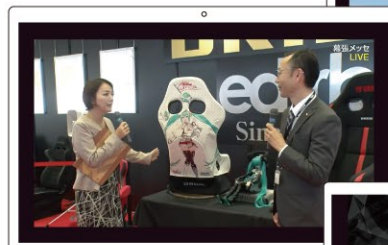

Any category of base vehicle is acceptable. The key criteria for consideration are tuning excellence in engine and suspension, enhancement in the accessibility of the utility space, ingenious ideas for dress-up and as to how well-finished overall.
